YEAR END SPECIAL GIVING

At the end of each year, we as a church have an opportunity to engage in a strategic financial investment in the Lord's work through a special giving project. This year the focus will be an opportunity to invest on 2 fronts: **BCO Building Fund** - Though the church plant will provide some temporary relief from our facility need, BCO still faces a critical long-term need for a larger facility. We are incredibly encouraged and thankful for the \$2.8M that has been given so far as we continually move toward our \$6.8M goal.

IBC Church Plant Fund - providing initial funding for the launch of Immanuel Bible Church (our 2023 church plant)
