1. Consider how Isaiah 27:7-11 describes the just punishments necessary for Israel's sins to be atoned/removed. What alternate means does Isaiah 52:13-53:12 prophecy will be provided for "justifying the transgressors"?
2. Read Ezekiel 36:22-38 and 37:15-28 and ask whether each detail in the prophecy best describes 1) an already historical time, 2) the present "church age," 3) a still future earthly kingdom, or 4) heaven.
3. Resources for further study: *The Church in God's Program*, by Robert Saucy (broad overview); *Christ's Prophetic Plans*, by John MacArthur & Richard Mayhue (focused overview); *Amillennialism and the Age to Come*, by Matt Waymeyer (in-depth biblical study).
