2. What place would the reality of Eternal Security of Jesus' Sheep have in a Gospel conversation with an unbeliever? How might such a truth even be used as the central hub of a Gospel conversation?
3. What is the relationship between the perseverance of a believer and their own assurance of their Eternal Security (see 1 Pet 1:3-9, 1 John 3:8-9, 5:18). How might this relationship be misunderstood?
