1. What are your "top 3" works of Jesus (as recorded in 4 Gospels) that most amaze you? Why? Mark them in your Bible for ready reference in conversations...
2. In Titus 2:1-10 — identify specific behaviors that serve to "adorn the doctrine of God our Savior" (v.10)...
3. How exactly might you incorporate "Jesus' works" into the conversation as you are sharing Jesus' message of the Gospel with an unbeliever? What specific works would be best to include, and why?
4. Thought Question: If Jesus' Defense (part 1) included showing the inconsistency of his accuser's own standards of right and wrong, what might this look like related to some common objections we get to the Gospel... For instance: "There are lots of religions out there — how do I know yours is true?" OR "Christians have done all sorts of horrible things in history, so it can't be the true way..." OR others you have heard...

Parents: Children are always welcome to sit quietly in our Worship Together. If their activity or sounds begin to hinder the worship of others, we ask you escort them out in the spirit of Romans 12:10.
