YEAR END STRATEGIC GIVING

Each year the Elders identify a Year End Giving Project for our church that will strategically further the Lord's work among us or our missionary partners. Having a present surplus in our Mission Fund with which to bless our Missionaries this year, we recognize that our Facility need is our church's most pressing project. We are excited to be soon receiving a detailed assessment of our immediate options from Master's Plan Construction (initial design review Monday) and anticipate being able to take a strategic step in 2025 toward meeting our longterm building need. LEGACY STANDARD BIBLE VERSION

In 2020 we established the ESV (English Standard Version) as our church's "official" Bible version for consistency in worship and teaching and verse memory. Though we appreciate and value several excellent modern English Bible translations (NASB, ESV, NKJV), our choice of ESV was primarily due to it being at that time the only version available for Adventure Club. Since that time, 2 developments have happened. 1) Legacy Standard Bible (LSB) was published in 2021 (a vast improvement over the 2020 version of the NASB, which had shifted away from its rigorous translation philosophy), 2) as of 2025, Adventure Club materials became available in LSB. Thus, based on our original preference for the superior translation of the NASB (now carried forward by the LSB), the Elders unanimously decided to change our official Bible to the LSB in May 2025. We still appreciate and value the ESV and NKJV, but feel the LSB is the best English version for reading and study.
