DIGGING DEEPER : *Reflecting on Today's Sermon*

1. What does a person whose hope is genuinely fixed on Christ's return look like in daily life? What tends to pull your own hope downward toward the things of this world instead?
2. How does understanding holiness as identity rather than performance change the way you pursue it? Where do you still tend to treat it as a project rather than a fruit?
3. The list in 2:1 — malice, deceit, hypocrisy, envy, slander — describes the specific vices that destroy love in community. Which of these five poses the greatest threat to genuine fellowship in relationships, and why?
4. The sermon said: "Your worth is not self-generated. Your worth is God-assigned." How does living from this identity — rather than toward it — change your posture toward your failures, your slander from others, and your service in the church?
